Czech Society of **Clinical Biochemistry**



The Czech Society of Clinical Biochemistry is part of the Czech Medical Association of Jan Evangelista Purkyně and, as of July 31, 2024, has 1,001 members. These include 785 university graduates and 210 laboratory assistants, making it one of the largest national societies for laboratory medicine in Europe. Among the graduates, there are 206 medical doctors and 579 scientists. The Society also includes 21 foreign members from Slovakia.

The initial meeting of the clinical chemistry section of the Czech Medical Society of J. E. Purkyně took place on October 10, 1958. An electoral meeting followed on March 20, 1959, during which Prof. Jaroslav Hořejší was elected the first president. The Czech Society of Clinical Chemistry was officially established on April 24, 1959.

Since 1946, a group of laboratory assistants has been organizing the national BIOLAB meetings, predating the establishment of the Society itself. After the split of Czechoslovakia, the Society began organizing a national Congress every two years, along with many additional regional or topic-focused meetings.

The Society's most prestigious awards include the Hořejší Medal, the Prize for the Best Publication, and the Prize for the Best Educational Material, which are awarded annually.

A significant part of the Society's activities involves issuing guidelines and recommendations on various topics, such as cardiac markers, diabetes mellitus, tumor markers, personal glucometer usage, POCT, Down syndrome screening, EQA, IQA, and cerebrospinal fluid analysis.

In 2008, the Society signed a contract with EDMA to launch the Czech version of Lab Tests Online, aimed at educating both patients and clinicians.

The Society publishes a quarterly journal, Clinical Biochemistry and Metabolism (Klinická biochemie a metabolismus), in print since 1993. The journal focuses on clinical biochemistry, pathophysiology, pathobiochemistry, nutritional support, and nuclear medicine. It features reviews, original research papers, case reports, and methodological studies. Over the past five years, it has also served as the official journal of the Society of Medical Genetics.

The Czech Society of Clinical Biochemistry has been cooperating on EQA since 1992 and maintains a close relationship with SEKK, the national EQA organizer. Over the last decade, we have been continuously developing and enhancing the accreditation system for medical laboratories. Laboratories accredited under ISO 15189 (and some under ISO 17025) use the national accreditation body, the Czech Institute of Accreditation, while some are also certified under ISO 9001. Additionally, the Czech Medical Association has established the National Accreditation Body for Clinical Laboratories, which conducts lab audits.

The 2nd European Congress of Clinical Chemistry was held in Prague in October 1976, with 1,500 experts in attendance. Prague also hosted EuroMedLab 2001, which attracted over 2,800 scientists. In 2004, the FESCC Symposium in Prague focused on postgraduate education, with 80 delegates from European clinical chemistry societies participating. The Czech Society of Clinical Biochemistry also organized the EFCC Symposium on Education in Clinical Chemistry in 2012, with 80 delegates. Since 2015, the biennial CELME symposium has been held, with the fifth edition in 2023 focusing on Analytical Performance Specifications.

Prague has nearly 1,4 million inhabitants. It is the seat of the president of Czech Republic and home to all the main cultural and educational institutions. In 1348 the Charles University was founded as one of the oldest universities in Europe.

Prague is a gateway to the Czech Republic and it is an important European centre.

Prague is one of the safest cities in Europe and ranks among the top 5 safest cities.



In 1992, the historical core of the city (866 hectares) was listed in the UNESCO as a town with a unique and lively blend of roman, gothic, renaissance, baroque, Art Nouveau and cubist architecture.

Prague was one of nine European cities awarded the title European City of Culture 2000.

Prague is among the most visited European cities.

Prague Spirit

Over the centuries, people have invented such nicknames for Prague as the City of a Hundred Spires, Golden Prague or Magic Prague always celebrating its architectural and spiritual richness and its mystical attraction.

Panoramic views of Prague are truly breathtaking. When you look out over the city from the **Prague Castle**, you will see why it is called the City of a Hundred Spires. Prague has always been a living organism, where over the centuries all European architectural styles have appeared. Prague is also a **city for romance**. Evenings strolls through the narrow streets in the glow of old street lamps, exploring almost forgotten nooks and corners of the Old Town. All these experiences are not forgottable.

When one mentions Czech music, many will immidiately think of the composer Antonin Dvorak, who was inspired by Prague to create world-known musical masterpieces. Prague Spring festival of classical music, is held in May and June at such venues as the Rudolfinum and the Municipal House. You can learn about the life of Antonin Dvorak, whose Symphony No 9, known as From the New World, was played when American astronauts first landed on the Moon, at a museum inVilla America.

The National Gallery in Prague manages the largest collection of art in the Czech Republic. The collections of the gallery are not housed in a single building, but are presented in a number of historic structures. The largest of the gallery sites is the Veletržní Palác which houses the National Gallery's collection of modern art.

From our trips and journeys you bring home experinces and memories, there is a wide range of souvenirs you can take back from Prague as the famous Bohemian glass (traditional hand-cut vases, bowls, drinking glasses) and Bohemian garnets.





Easy Access

The capital city of the Czech Republic is often called the "Heart of Europe" for the central position it occupies both in terms of importance and geography. Thanks to its favourable geographical position, Prague is a suitable destination for conferences and congresses.

The city can be reached from all European countries and cities very easily. Prague is accessible from four motorways – the D1 from the southeast (near the Austrian border), the D5 from the southwest (near the German border), D8 motorway from the northwest and D11 motorway from the east. Prague is also accessible by train, bus or plane. The main railway station and the main coach station are right in the centre of town.

Nowadays the city of Prague plays an important role as one of the key traffic points in Europe, especially as a gate to access its eastern part. Prague's Airport handles around 250 flights a day and approximately fifty carriers who operate direct connections, scheduled and charter, to 103 destinations around the world making this airport immense, 1,2 million people used the airport just in July alone, around the same number of people who live in Prague itself.

According to the number of passengers passing through the terminals, Prague Airport is now among the top 20 airports in Europe. This is aided by the number of budget airlines now benefiting from Prague's location in Central Europe. These companies now link Prague with 20 cities in Europe.

Prague Main railway station is located 5 minutes walk from Wenceslas Square. Connection to 0, Universum is by metro line C to Florenc one stop, change to line B and get off 4 stops at Ceskomoravská and walk cca 7 minutes.

Prague is accessible by many highways from Berlin, Nürnberg, München, Vienna.



Žofín Palace


Situated in the heart of Prague on Slovanský Island, approx. 150 m from The National Theatre. Žofín Palace has been a leading centre of cultural and social life in Prague since 1837. Neo-Renaissance building was rebuilt in 1886 by architect Henry Fialka. The cassette rich stucco ceiling with paintings and figural panels of the main hall.





Municipal House

The Municipal House, a national cultural landmark, is among the most significant Art Nouveau buildings in Prague. It is located in the very centre of Prague, directly neighbouring the Powder Gate. The most significant Czech painters and sculptors of the time participated in the decoration of the Municipal House. That list included: Jan Preisler, Mikoláš Aleš, Max Švabinský, František Ženíšek, Ladislav Šaloun, Josef Mařatka, Josef Václav Myslbek, Alfons Mucha. Since the very beginning, the Municipal House has been a multifunctional building. The halls and lounges are used to arrange conventions, conferences, concerts, balls and fashion shows. They are accessible to the general public only in the form of commented tours. In the years 1994 - 1997 the Municipal House underwent a technically and financially demanding restoration. When it was re-opened, it once again became a significant social and cultural centre.
